This should be done by means of a distribution truck, tack rig, or tack broom. All can be purchased or APPLICATION:

WEATHER Application should be postponed if wet or freezing weather is expected 24 hours before or following the **LIMITATIONS:**

application. On hot days, pavement should be misted with a fog system before application.

COLOR: Jet black color upon drying.

CLEAN UP: Use warm water with an emulsifying cleaner.

STORAGE: Keep from freezing. Do not store in direct sunlight or where temperatures exceed 100F.

PACKAGING: Onsite bulk material loadout. 5 Gallon Buckets are available for pickup or delivery, individually or pal-

letized, for your convenience.
